



2012 City Championship Tournament Summary



1. In 2012 there will be eight (8) City Tournament Divisions:

Little League Minor Baseball Little League Major Baseball
Junior Baseball Senior League Baseball
Little League Minor Softball Little League Major Softball
Junior League Softball (12-14) Senior League Softball (13-16)
2. In the Little League Minor Tournament, there may be a 12 year old player on a regular season team allowed by Little League under a waiver form in these Minor Baseball Tournaments. (Note 12 yr olds cannot pitch.)
3. All City Championship Tournaments are for Regular Season LEAGUE CHAMPIONS of each Little League in those respective divisions. If you league does not determine league champions your league can elect to send one or more teams chosen by your Board of Directors to represent your league.
4. Leagues are requested to enter one team in each division for each charter that the league holds, i.e. if your league has two charters American and National, your league may elect to send one League Champion for each charter. If room is available in the schedule, additional teams such as League Champions and/or 2nd Place and etc. will be allowed.
5. Every team will be allowed to bring up two additional players within certain restrictions. (See rules for each division).
6. All players on every team must have been a regular season team member for at least 60% of the regular season, unless a waiver is presented and approved prior to the tournaments.
7. Since these are regular season teams only, players may not be added or replaced on the City Tournament affidavit.
8. Please note that ALL City Tournaments are now using Tournament Rules. Please refer to the T Section in the Little League Rule Books and the City Championship Rules for that division for rules or exceptions that apply.
9. Baseball MUST utilize the pitch count as per the Tournament Rules for the proper division.
10. Both Base Coaches may be adult manager and/or coaches provided that there is one adult manager or coach in the dugout.
11. City Tournaments are single elimination due to time constraints and field availability.
12. **Reminder: For ALL City Championship Tournaments, Home Team must furnish an adult announcer.** (Scorekeeper is furnished by the Host League)
13. Home Team will occupy 1st base dugout and Visitor Team will occupy 3rd base dugout for all tournaments in District 19.
14. Team Managers/Coaches MUST attend the mandatory managers/coaches meeting and turn in two (2) signed and completed copies of the City Tournament Affidavit.
